- we integrate our suppliers and service providers in our environmental programs
- we actively inform our employees about our environmental principles and constantly make them aware of all aspects involved
- we will ensure compliance with legislation both on European and national level; we will also participate in shaping future environmental legislation through communication with national and European legislative bodies
- we are committed to continuous improvement of the Environmental Management System
- we are setting, where possible, quantitative targets to ensure compliance with internal and external requirements
